What is the Principles Exam



The principles exam is a little different than traditional exams, and it is important to note those differences to maximize your preparation.

How it is different:

- 1. Every single principles event takes the same test
 - a. Why? Principles is supposed to be an intro to business event, with a slight concentration in one of the major core clusters. As a result, the test is called the General Business Knowledge Exam.
- 2. How does it differ from the cluster exams?
 - a. If you look at the Exam Blueprints, you will notice that cluster specific exams are heavy on Instructional Areas that are specifically important to that cluster. Principles exams prioritize basic business skills like communications, customer relations, and emotional intelligence.
